World Lake Day Special: A New Approach to Connecting Lakes and Rivers (Video Clip and Concept Paper) On the occasion of World Lake Day, we are pleased to share the recording of the international online meeting held on 25 August 2025.

Organized by the ILEC Scientific Committee, the session explored a concept called ILLBM (Integrated Lentic-Lotic Basin Management), which views lakes, rivers, and other flowing waters as one connected system.

Case studies such as Chilika Lake in India and Lake Chapala in Mexico were discussed, combining local knowledge with scientific perspectives to consider future directions for water governance.

Through this initiative, ILEC contributes to World Lake Day by providing scientific insights for sustainable lake management.
